HOPE FOR DEPRESSION RESEARCH FOUNDATION

Cocktails and caviar kick-off inaugural Palm Beach 'Race of HOPE'

Friday, Dec. 7 — The Royal Poinciana Plaza, Palm Beach

Hope for Depression Research Foundation (HDRF) held a festive cocktail party and dinner to announce its upcoming Palm Beach 5K Race of HOPE on Sunday, Jan. 27. The event was hosted by HDRF founder and chair Audrey Gruss, and Scott Snyder. The two are Co-Grand Marshals of the Race of HOPE, the first of its kind in Palm Beach.

More than 200 people gathered under the night sky in The Royal Poinciana Plaza's courtyard for a cocktail reception. Whilst guests mingled, HDRF staff registered walkers and runners for the 5K Race, which comes to Palm Beach after three successful years in Southampton. The race raises awareness and funds for urgent depression research.

"You can run, you can walk, you can stroll, you can bring your children, your babies in strollers, your dog - whatever keeps you moving," said Snyder about the race. Added Gruss, "The point is to come together and give each other positive energy to defeat depression, the number one cause of disability worldwide."

Following cocktails, a select group of race committee members and top sponsors filled Sant Ambroeu's for a celebratory four-course dinner. A highlight of the dinner was an array of caviars served, provided by the evening's top sponsor, Black River Caviar CEO Graham Gaspard. Gaspard announced he would happily take orders of caviar during the evening and donate 50 percent of the proceeds to HDRF. This resulted in donations totaling \$17,000 to HDRF by the end of the night, all of which will go directly to helping advance depression research.
