English-born celebrity model Hicks (who at age 13 was a bridesmaid in the wedding of **Prince Charles** to Lady Diana Spencer) lives in Harbour Island in the Bahamas, from where she culls much of the design aesthetic that informs her eponymous lifestyle brand. A selection of Hicks’ clothing, accessories, home furnishing items and gifts were presented in a trunk show at the store.

The afternoon included a conversation with Hicks and Turner moderated by store co-founder **Caroline Rafferty**, cocktails and hors d’oeuvres made from Turner’s own recipes, and book signings of Hicks’ “A Slice of England” and Turner’s “I Love California.”

More than 100 people attended the daylong event, including **Mary McDonald**, the LA-based interior designer who is one of the stars of Bravo TV’s “Million Dollar Decorators.”
