## Pumpkin patch to return for family event Saturday at the Royal Poinciana Plaza



Trick or treating, games, bluegrass concert and beer garden among the activities planned for event benefiting the Cancer Alliance of Help & Hope at the shopping center in Palm Beach.

If the spooky costumes and ripe pumpkins lining the aisles at local stores have put you in the mood for Halloween, you can get a jump on the holiday from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. Saturday in the West Courtyard at the [Royal Poinciana Plaza](#), where about 800 pumpkins will be up for grabs.

Money raised during the Pop-Up Patch for Philanthropy will benefit the [Cancer Alliance of Help & Hope](#). The Palm Beach County nonprofit helps qualified local cancer patients by paying a portion of their non medical bills, supplementing their basic needs and providing support and information.

Guests who donate to the charity can take home a pumpkin, while supplies last. In addition, visitors can trick or treat, play games and snack on fall spice cotton candy.

Several stores will join in the festivities. There will be a cookie station at Toojay's Gourmet Deli, pumpkin decorating at Alice + Olivia, and a hot chocolate bar at Zadig & Voltaire. Stores marked with a maple leaf logo will donate a portion of their sales to the Cancer Alliance of Help and Hope.

From 3 to 6 p.m., [The Lubben Brothers](#) will play bluegrass music and [Coyo Taco Palm Beach's](#) beer garden will be open.
